NOTICE is also given that on or after Monday the 5 September 2011 from 10.00 am, until the completion of the audit the auditor, at the request of a local government elector for any area to which the accounts relate, will give the elector, or his representative an opportunity to question him about or make objections to the accounts for the year ended 31 March, 2011. Any such elector or his representative objecting to the accounts may ask the auditor to issue a report in the public interest (under section 8 of the Audit Commission Act 1998) and/or apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law (under section 17 of that Act).
